Personal Qualities

Amongst the personal qualities you will need as our CD are:

- * The ability to lead, and drive us genially on to be our best
- * The ability to inspire and share vision and purpose
- * The ability to switch roles between 'leader' and 'team player' as needed
- * Management of other people such as the Deputy CD and Section Leaders
- * Musical and teaching ability.

You will need to be receptive to barbershop style, although we do not sing this exclusively.

Passion and enthusiasm are more important than previous conducting experience. If you are right for us we will work with your skills. We encourage applicants from all backgrounds.

You will need to commit in principle for a reasonable time, and be prepared to work in harmony with the committee.

Job Profile

1. The Chorus Director and Deputy Chorus Director are appointed by the Club Management Committee. The Chorus Director shall be an active member of the Music Committee, and will carry out his/her duties to the Management Committee's satisfaction.
2. The Chorus Director shall:
 - a. Work towards the Club's aims, specifically, to improve singing and performance.
 - b. To help grow the chorus, especially younger members.
 - c. To encourage and promote the musical education of members.
3. The responsibilities of the Chorus Director are to:
 - * Deliver the programme on club nights, deploying others where appropriate, e.g. the Deputy CD and section leaders
 - * Encourage the training of self and others, e.g., Deputy CD and section leaders
 - * Enable the provision of guest educators from time to time
 - * Direct the chorus at Surrey Fringe shows, music festivals and competitions.
 - * Direct singouts by mutual agreement
4. The Club will finance attendance at BABS Directors' College and may, at the Committee's discretion, provide assistance for other occasions.
